

Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Coast 2016

Our 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon shows bright cherry flavors and black pepper spiciness encompassed in a medium-bodied, delicious wine. Our vineyard is located in the northern district of Paso Robles, which has slightly warmer days and cooler evening climates. We have created a fruit forward and eminently drinkable single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon. After aging in 60-gallon American oak barrels for 6 months, this wine has a deliberate cabernet structure with proper amounts of tannins and viscosity. This Cabernet Sauvignon is showing beautifully now and will age nicely over the next 3-5 years.
