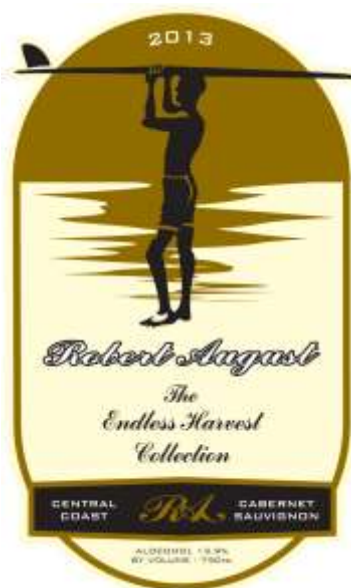




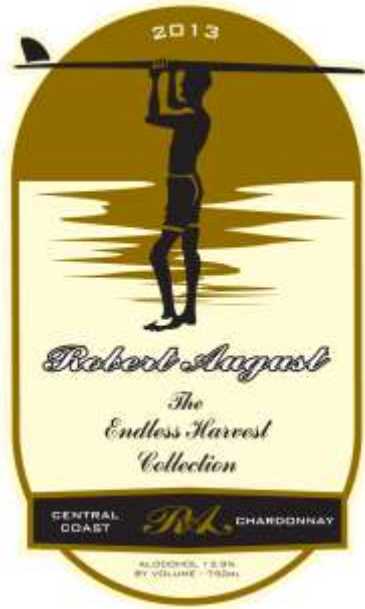
ROBERT AUGUST WINES

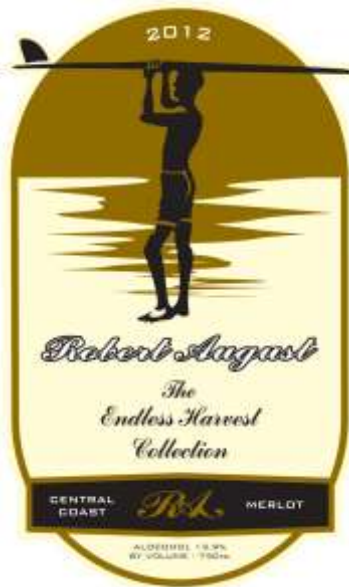
Robert August 2013 Central Coast Cabernet Sauvignon:

Catch a wave of wonderful cherry flavors and hints of spice. This Central Coast Cabernet Sauvignon is a lip smacker with a finish that offers a long ride. Stoke your palate with structured notes of dark cherries, and macadamia nuts. Rich spices from aging 12 months in 60 gallon oak barrels. Yum!



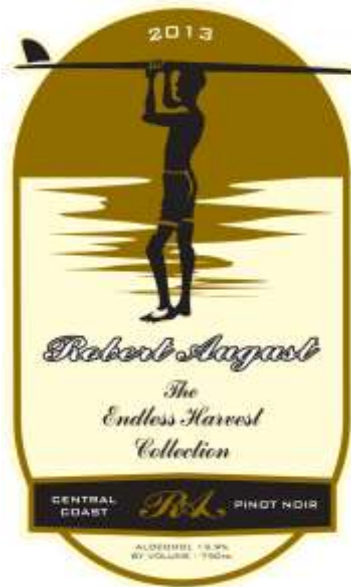
Robert August 2013 Central Coast Chardonnay:

Get tubed inside this delicious mouthful of tropical fruit flavors. This Central Coast Chardonnay is a barrel of wonderfulness. Every time you pull the cork, you will smell aromas of the tropics. Grab your board and a tall wine glass and enjoy the ride.



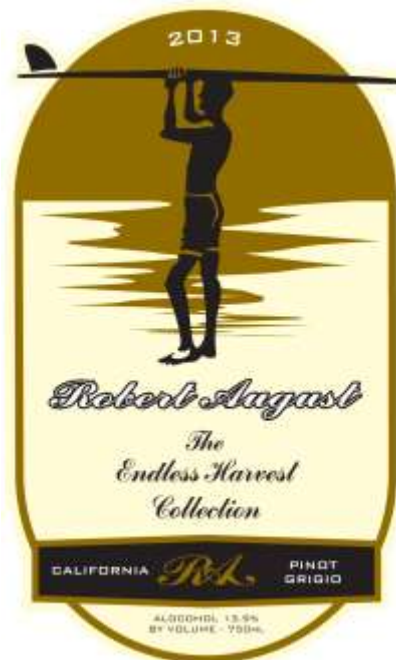
Robert August 2013 Central Coast Merlot:

The intense flavors of this scrumptious merlot hit you like a large set at Wiamea Bay. Enjoy the ride as you inhale the fresh aromas of cherry, raspberry, currant and plum. After aging the wine 12 months in 60 gallon oak barrels, the wine shows some delicious spices on the finish.



Robert August 2013 Central Coast Pinot Noir:

Delicious flavors of ripe red fruit, cherry and a hint of chocolate permeate from this delicate Pinot Noir. The coastal influences surrounding this Central Coast vineyard have permitted the vines to thrive and enhanced the aromas. A long finish with toast and spices – perfect after a great day of surfing.



Robert August 2013 California Pinot Grigio:

Like a cool morning breeze, this Pinot Grigio delivers a breath of fresh air to your mouth and nose. This medium bodied wine shows hints of pear and apple. As King Kamehameha once said “ pour me a Pinot Grigio and I will ensure you a fine afternoon of surf.” Delicate and floral – Cowabunga!
