Vineyard

The 2016 growing season began with generous winter rains, followed by a spring and summer marked by moderate temperatures and abundant sunshine. Like several recent vintages, the 2016 harvest came early, delivering exquisite quality grapes. After the modest size crop of 2015, 2016 saw a welcome return to average yields. Overall, the 2016 whites show an ideal combination of lovely richness and excellent natural acidity

Winemaking

The grapes were whole-cluster pressed on the same day they were picked. The juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures to preserve the delicate fruit aromas. This results in a nice crisp fresh wine.

Tasting Notes

Summertime in a glass. Our Sauvignon Blanc has a bright floral and citrus aromas. The crisp flavors of Asian pear, apple, lemon and white peach with a hint of minerality that transition into vivid, crisp acidity, supporting flavors honeysuckle and grapefruit. Elegant, but with a vibrant intensity of flavors, the wine has a dry crisp, refreshing finish which is perfect for your summertime affairs
