RUSSIAN RIVER SLIPPERY SLOPE CHARDONNAY 2014

Russian River Valley is arguably one of the best places to grow Burgundian varietals in all of California. Tank fermented and aged sur-lie in barrel for 12 months with frequent stirring of the lees produced a wine with rich flavors and excellent palate weight. Aged 12 months in French oak barrels helped to provide complexity with vanilla, spice, and rich oak overtones. The wine went through complete malolactic fermentation, which shows in the soft roundness on the palate.
