## CABERNET SAUVIGNON CENTRAL COAST 2017

The mature berry flavors and spiciness which originates from our prime Paso Robles vineyards have resulted in a fruit forward and eminently drinkable Cabernet Sauvignon.

After aging in 60-gallon American oak barrels for 8 months, this wine has a deliberate cabernet structure with proper amounts of tannins and viscosity. This Cabernet Sauvignon is showing beautifully now and will age nicely over the next 3-5 years.
