



## 2019 PINOT GRIGIO, CALIFORNIA

INSPIRED BY THE WARM CALIFORNIA SUMMER, OUR PINOT GRIGIO HAILS FROM OUR 2001 VINEYARD IN CLARKSBURG, A SMALL YET PROMINENT GRAPE-GROWING REGION ALONGSIDE THE SACRAMENTO RIVER DELTA. THIS LIGHT-BODIED WHITE WINE SHOWS PEAR, NECTARINE, AND APPLE FLAVORS, WITH AN ALLURING CITRUS FINISH. IT SHOWS BEAUTIFULLY NOW, BUT IT CONTINUES TO DEVELOP WITH TIME.
