



## FIVE VINTNERS WINES

**2018 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY.** Finally, a vintage post drought! The 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon conjures dreams of braised short ribs and holiday baked goods. Loaded with aromas and flavors of tart cherry and plum, this Cabernet is rich and audacious (my friend Miriam helped me with that big word!), with balanced tannins and integrated oak. This is a Cab you can drink TONIGHT! Or you can cellar it, but why wait? After 18 months of aging in 40% new French oak barrels, this wine was bottled on the second day of Summer in 2020. Only 466 Cases Produced.

**2017 ZINFANDEL, DRY CREEK VALLEY.** Bigger is better, right? This is riper, juicier and has more pepper spice than prior vintages while maintaining balance. The 2017 vintage was a great one for Zinfandel from Dry Creek Valley, demonstrating a depth of character, big mouth feel and bold flavors! Aging for 18 months in 20% new French Oak barrels adds richness and hint of toasty caramel flavors and aromas. Enjoy with your hearty pasta dishes, grilled sausages and pork tenderloin. Only 340 Cases Produced.

**2019 SAUVIGNON BLANC, ADMIRAL'S VINEYARD, NAPA VALLEY.** We continue to adore our **ORGANICALLY FARMED** one-acre vineyard, planted in front of a friend's house in '02. This is our **14th** vintage from the Admiral's Vineyard, and it always delivers! Picked at the peak of flavor, while acids are still super bright and sugars are not too sweet, the 2019 Sauvignon Blanc is crisp and bright, with nice body, and is loaded with citrus aromas. Only 323 Cases Produced.

## THE HISTORY OF FIVE VINTNERS WINES

### CONTINUING THE FAMILY TRADITION

Krisi Raymond represents the fifth generation in her family to grow grapes and make wine in the Napa Valley. Her family roots run deep, dating back to 1876 when her great-great-grandfather Jacob Beringer, together with his brother Frederick, established Beringer Brothers Winery just north of St. Helena. The next generation continued to produce wine through Prohibition for medicinal and sacramental purposes. It was in 1933 with the repeal of Prohibition that Roy Raymond began his career in the wine industry at Beringer Brothers Winery and in 1936 married Martha Jane Beringer, grand-daughter of Jacob Beringer. Their two sons, Roy Jr. and Walter, continued the family's winemaking tradition at Beringer Brothers Winery after attending college. With the sale of Beringer to Nestle Corporation in 1970, the Raymond family purchased 90 acres of prime vineyard land south of St. Helena on Zinfandel Lane and founded Raymond Vineyard & Cellar. They planted a variety of wine grapes on the property and crushed their first vintage in 1974. In 2001, Krisi Raymond stepped out on her own as a grape grower and winemaker. With just one acre of her own organically grown Sauvignon Blanc and a handful of select grape growers she produces fine Napa Valley wines. Krisi focus' on her favorite varietals: Cabernet Sauvignon, Zinfandel and Sauvignon Blanc.
