PLANTED IN 1982 ON AN EAST-WEST AXIS, OUR CENTRAL COAST PINOT NOIR'S 40-ACRE VINEYARD IS LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SANTA MARIA VALLEY. THE PREVALENT FOG AND OCEAN BREEZE MAKE THIS GROWING REGION IDEAL FOR THIS OPULENT WINE; HOWEVER, THE WARMER DAY TEMPERATURES ALLOW FOR A MORE FRUIT FORWARD FINISH ON THE NOSE AND FOR THE PALLET.
