

Discover Our 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon – A Rich and Graceful Blend. Our 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon is crafted from the finest fruits in Alexander Valley and Dry Creek Valley, the most sought–after appellations for this variety in Sonoma County. This wine boasts a full–bodied, elegant flavor with layered, ripe fruit impressions of blackberries and blueberries. Its mouthfeel is full and round, with expertly structured tannins that create a smooth texture. Subtle notes of dark chocolate, vanilla bean, and light spices add depth to the wine, finishing with an extended and lasting aftertaste.

Winemaking

Harvested on September 6, 2019 at 25.0. degrees brix, our Cabernet fermented ten days at 72F to dryness. We then macerated an additional 20 days to soften and develop the tannins, and to extract additional color. Following pressing, the wine was moved to 60/gl French Oak barrels and aged for sixteen months. We hope that you enjoy our wines just as we do at the winery.
